Article 1

This Regulations is prescribed in accordance with Paragraph 6 of Article 55 of the Civil Aviation Act (hereinafter referred to as The Act).

Article 2

The term of remote offshore islands used in the Regulations herein are defined as below:

- 1) Penghu County.
- 2) Kinmen County.
- 3) Lienchiang County.
- 4) Lanyu Township and Lyudao Township in Taitung County.

Article 3

The residents who have registered their residence in the remote offshore islands pursuant to the preceding article and take flights of domestic scheduled routes from or to their residence will be allowable to apply for airfare subsidies by presenting their original ID cards or household certificates.

The measures of airfare subsidies set forth in the preceding paragraph are as follows:

1)The subsidies of Magong Airport in Penghu county and Shangyi Airport in Kinmen county shall be 20 percent of the airfare.

2)The subsidies of Nangan Airport and Beigan Airport in Lienchiang county shall be 30 percent of the airfare.

3)The subsidies of both Cimei Airport and Wangan Airport in Penghu county , also Lanyu Airport and Lyudao Airport in Taitung county shall be 40 percent of airfare.

The airfare subsidies for the residents who take flights between their residence and other remote offshore islands will receive a higher subsidy according to the airport specified in the preceding paragraph.

Article 4

Whenever a resident living in a remote offshore island applies for the airfare subsidies in accordance with paragraph 1 of the preceding article, whereby the airlines shall identify the resident's status and fill relevant information in the Airfare Subsidies List (as shown in Attachment 1) in advance. The Civil Aeronautics Administration of Ministry of Transportation And Communications (hereinafter referred to as CAA) may perform a spot-check if necessary.

The airlines shall submit both the Airfare Subsidies List and Advance Payments List of Airfare Subsidies (as shown in Attachment 2) occurring in the previous month to CAA for the purpose of verification and appropriation before 10th of each month.

Article 5

The residents, who have registered their residence in the remote offshore islands, that took flights of domestic scheduled routes from or to their residence through the airports of Nangan, Beigan, Cimei, Wangan, Lanyu or Lyudao during the period between January 25, 2009 (amendment date of The Act) and April 5, 2009 (one day prior to the amendment date of this Regulations) who would like to apply for the balance of airfare subsidies in accordance with amended regulations shall present their original ID cards or household certificates before December 31, 2009.

When a qualified applicant entrusts another person to apply for the balance of airfare subsidies, the consignee shall present the following document: the principal's ID card or household certificate, the Authorization Letter (as shown in Attachment 3) and the consignee's original ID card.

When a qualified applicant in accordance with paragraph 1 is deceased, the legal heir can apply for the balance of airfare subsidies by presenting the household certificate transcription or other identity document of the applicant and the legal heir; supposed that the number of legal heir are more than one person, the application shall be submitted by one representative legal heir along with the attachment of Legal Heirs' Authorization Letter (as shown in Attachment 4) in addition.

Article 6

When the legal heir applies for the balance of airfare subsidies in accordance with the preceding article, whereby the airlines shall identify the applicant's status and ask him to affix his signature or seal on the balance of Airfare Subsidies List (as shown in Attachment 5) prior to the actual payment procedure. CAA may perform a spot-check if necessary.

The airlines shall submit the balance of Airfare Subsidies List pursuant to the preceding paragraph along with Advance Payments List of Airfare Subsidies to CAA for the purpose of verification and appropriation before January 10th, 2010.

Article 7

The budget to implement this regulations is prescribed by CAA with official budget or CAA Operating Fund.

Article 8

This Regulations shall become effective on the date of promulgation.
