### **Subject :**

It is the responsibility of all operators to provide the highest level of safety in air transportation and to provide flight operations in accordance with CAA Aircraft Operations Regulations.

### **Subscription :**

After landing, the aircraft of one national airlines ran off the runway resulting in the damage of the nose wheel and right engine.

### **Recommendation :**

1. Operators should review their flight training, standardization and check programs to ensure flight crew competency is maintained relating to wet runway, cross wind and thunderstorm conditions.
2. In order to operate flights in compliance with aircraft/flight operations manuals and flight safety, strict cockpit discipline and CRM must be maintained. The pilot monitoring must be alert to deteriorating inside/outside conditions and keep the pilot flying well informed.
