SUBJECT :

To prevent unauthorized access to aircrafts, please strengthen security control of aircrafts.

BACKGROUND :

An airline did not close the cabin door when the aircraft was not carrying out a flight duty and no person was working inside the aircraft which caused an unauthorized person to access to the cabin. Although the staff of airport ground handling service found the unauthorized person in the cabin, the staff did not verify the person's identity. The unauthorized person stayed in cabin until cabin crews conducted pre-flight security check and reported to Aviation Police Office. The unauthorized person had been conducted a suit by local procurator in accordance with the Civil Aviation Act.

RECOMMODATION :

1. In order to prevent unauthorized person access to aircrafts which parked at the airport overnight, the owner or operator of the aircrafts shall establish security measures or procedures to follow the Article 7 of Regulations on Safeguarding Civil Aviation Against Acts of Unlawful Interference, "The owner or operator of an aircraft shall close the cabin door or passenger boarding bridge when the aircraft is not carrying out a flight duty and no person is working inside the aircraft, and shall also remove the mobile staircases and service ladders."
2. All entities in airport shall monitor all activities from persons or vehicles at their operation area automatically. If any suspicious indication has been discovered, further action shall be taken immediately and related entities shall be notified if necessary.

OTHERS:

"Regulations on Safeguarding Civil Aviation Against Acts of Unlawful Interference" had been promulgated on FEB. 25, 2008. Any relevant organizations and enterprises shall fully comply with the above regulation. If any person or organization violates the above regulation, he/she shall be subject to a fine in accordance with the Article 112-4 of Civil Aviation Act hereafter.
