Aviation Safety Bulletin

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SUBJECT :

Ground handling staffs in a foreign station of one national airline found Magnetized Material Label used on 2 packages carried by their freighter without shipper's declaration. The packages had been classified as Class 9 dangerous goods (Proper Shipper Name: Magnetized material; UN Number:2807)

BACKGROUND :

1. Investigation indicates that the shipper did not comply with the Article 11 of Regulation Governing the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air to ensure that the dangerous goods are properly classified, identified, packed, marked, labeled, declared and accompanied by a Dangerous Good Declaration and other transport document before offering the dangerous goods for transport by air
2. Air freight forwarder and air cargo entrepot couldn't find the dangerous good label when accept and build up the packages.

RECOMMODATION :

1. Shippers shall establish the personnel training programs for dangerous goods, administer training and tests on their personnel in carrying out their responsibilities with regard to the transport of dangerous goods by air, and ensure that the dangerous goods are properly classified, identified, packed, marked, labeled, declared and accompanied by a dangerous good declaration and other transport document before offering the dangerous goods for transport by air in accordance with the Article 11 & Article 24 of Regulation Governing the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air.
2. Air freight forwarder, air cargo entrepot and the owner or operator of an aircraft shall enhance the training of identifying hidden dangerous goods.
3. Security authority of each airport shall enhance security screening for air cargo.

OTHERS:

Regulation Governing the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air had been promulgated on FEB. 25, 2008. Any relevant organizations, enterprises, and shippers shall fully comply with the above regulation when transporting dangerous good by air. CAA had also published the list of dangerous goods on MAY 5, 2008; therefore, any person or organizations who violates the above regulation when transporting dangerous goods by air shall be subject to a fine in accordance with the Article 112-2 of Civil Aviation Act hereafter.
