

Airworthiness Certification Process

The CAA requires several basic steps to obtain an airworthiness certificate in either the Standard or Special class.

The CAA may issue an applicant an airworthiness certificate when:

Registered owner or operator/agent [registers](#) aircraft,
Applicant submits [application](#) to the [CAA office](#), and
CAA determines the aircraft is eligible and in a [condition for safe operation](#)

CAA standard office can provide direct guidance and information to assist you in meeting your airworthiness interests. It is best to contact CAA office for direct guidance immediately after you register your aircraft.
