Background:

- 1. This bulletin is issued to all operators, dispatch and flight crew members to emphasize the importance of situation awareness surrounding weather phenomenon related to operations associated with severe weather, i.e. typhoons, tropical depressions, thunderstorms, etc.
- 2. Prior to arrival at the airport of intended landing, review weather and wind conditions, runway conditions, runway related hazards, aircraft performance, aircraft limitations, crew coordination, crew proficiency, crew limitations and total situation awareness. The final decision rests with the crew to provide that the highest level of safety is assured.

Recommendation:

1. There is only one acceptable operation, that is a "SAFE OPERATION."
