Subject :

One flight of a national carrier was suspectedly operated in a Controlled Flight into Terrain case, following an approach and resulted in the crash of this airplane. CAA will have to reiterate its constant policy to the operators—adherence to the regulation, follow SOP and awareness of discipline.

Prescription :

Training is the root to the assurance of aviation safety. The quality of training highly relies on the maintenance of disciplinary attitude and is paramount to the reduction of operational risks.

Recommendation :

CAA recommends the following items should be reinforced with all operators and observed by all flight crews:

- 1.Reinforce the concept of “STABLIZED APPROACH.” Ensure discipline is maintained throughout all training and flight operations.
- 2.Implement a must in operations---“Following procedures without short cut, diversion and go around are good for operations, and effective crew coordination is essential for safe operations.”
- 3.Spare no effort to follow the approach minima, and be proficient with go around procedure and decision making with the timing for go around. Implement crew resources management in operations.
